ENGLISH

1st Task:

For the project, you have to maintain a register as your daily diary. It should contain a daily written report based on the following activity.

You have to listen to the News bulletins on BBC and CNN every day. You have to write two daily reports about any two major events reported on each of the channel. The news reports of each channel should be written on a separate page. The work should be properly labeled with the day/ date/ and the name of the channel. A headline should be written for each day's news report.
